## SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Manuscripts must be original, unpublished and accompanied by an abstract of 250–300 words. Submissions should be made in MS Word format using Times New Roman font (12-point text and 10-point footnotes), 1.5-line spacing, justified alignment and the ILI Citation Style.

Author details should appear only on a separate cover page to facilitate double-blind peer review. Research Papers should ordinarily be 6,000–8,000 words, while Case Comments, Legislative Notes and Book Reviews should be 3,000–5,000 words. Upon publication, copyright in the manuscript shall vest in Dr. B.R. Ambedkar National Law University, Sonapat.


