Eligibility for admission

- Must have appeared for CLAT-PG 2025
- Candidates must possess a qualifying LL.B. degree or an equivalent examination with a
 minimum of <u>Fifty percent (50%)</u> marks or its equivalent grade in case of candidates
 belonging to General and OBC categories and <u>Forty-Five percent (45%)</u> marks or its
 equivalent grade in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST/PWD categories.

Eligibility Criteria for admission under Foreign National/NRI seats

- Academic record of LL.B. or equivalent degree recognized by the UGC/ Association of Indian Universities with not less than 50% marks or the equivalent grade.
- The candidate selection will be based on an interaction/interview.
- Candidates with TOEFL/ ILETS Score will be preferred.

Programme Structure

- Total Duration: One Academic Year
- Semester System: Two Semesters (Odd: July-December, Even: January-June).
- Maximum Completion Period: One year (extension possible with the permission of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor and on submission of prescribed fees).
